- In lowliness and meekness *Ephesians 4:2-6*

4. Does not act unbecomingly:

- The love of Christ constrains us (controls us) II Cor. 5:14
- The love of God should be shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost *Matt 5:5*

5. Does not seek its own, is not provoked

• Endeavor to keep the unity of the spirit in the bond of peace *Ephesian 4:2-6*

6. Does not take into account wrong suffered

- Above all things have fervent charity among yourselves; for charity shall cover the multitude of sins *I Peter 4:8*
- Love your enemies *Matt*
- Be rooted and grounded in love to understand the depth of God's love for us *Ephes 3:17*
- That your hearts might be comforted, being knit together in love Col. 2:2
- Faith worketh by love *Galatians 5:6*
