### **Are You Qualified for the Job?**

February 5, 2006

Matthew 17:14-21 (Mark 14:29)

## 1. The disciples had already been given the authority to do the work of God (Matt 10:1 & 8)

- He gave them power against unclean spirits, to cast then out, and to heal all manner of sickness and all manner of disease.
- Heal the sick, raise the dead, cast out devils
- They had been called and chosen
- Why did they fail?
  - 1. Were they trying to do it in their own power and ability?
  - 2. Did they distrust the power they had been given?
  - 3. Was it because Jesus or the other main disciples were not with them?

# 2. Jesus' frustration was with that whole generation that was stubborn and unbelieving

- <u>Because of unbelief</u> the power of GOD is limited to provide and deliver (Even Jesus could not do many miracles in his home town because of unbelief)
- But there was also <u>some frustration with his disciples</u> for they were a reflection of that attitude of unbelief exhibited by the multitude
- They had been given the authority but lack the knowledge of how to make use of it. They had not qualified themselves completely to do the job. This was a learning opportunity for them.

#### 3. A lack of pure faith that wholly relies on the power of God caused them to fail

- In essence "sin" was the cause of their failure unbelief is a sin.
- The same is true for us  $-\frac{\sin will disqualify us}{\cos w}$  to do the work we have been called and chosen to do for God.

### 4. What are some of the things that will disqualify us?

- Not being <u>properly dressed</u> for the type of warfare we are engaged in (Ephesians 6:10-17)
  - 1. loins girt about with **truth** truth (<u>God is</u>) and honesty (in us)
  - 2. breastplate of **righteousness** living unrighteous

- 3. feet shod with the preparation of the **gospel of peace** unprepared to spread the good news
- 4. shield of **faith** we are unable to <u>quench all the fiery darts</u> of the wicked
- 5. helmet of **salvation** we have to know that everything is given to us, total deliverance
- 6. sword of **the spirit** <u>the word</u> is the only offensive weapon we are given, we must know it to use it. It is the only thing we are given to inflict damage to Satan
- Poor <u>prayer and fasting</u> life (Ephesians 6:18) praying always with all prayer and supplication in the spirit, and watching with all patience
- <u>Sin</u> in our life breaks the fellowship with God, without which we can do nothing.
