Mark 16:17

- 1. Signs (miracles) that shall follow them that believe Miracles, valuable not so much for what they are, as for what they indicate of the grace and power of the believer or his connection with a higher spiritual world.
 - <u>Cast out devils (demons)</u> in the name of Jesus Acts 8:7 Phillip in Samaria, unclean spirits, with loud voice, came out of many that were possessed with them... And there was great joy in the city.
 - Speak with new tongues (languages of men) Act 2:4 Day of Pentecost in the upper room.
 - Take up serpents, and it shall not harm them Act 28:3-6 Paul as a prisoner after their shipwreck on the way to Rome was gathering sticks for a fire and a snake bite him... (Not an indication that we should try handling poisonous snakes to prove something)
 - Drink any deadly thing, it shall not harm them if satan tries to kill you with poison, he can't do it, unless GOD's willing.
 - Shall lay hands on the sick (morally sick or physically ill), and they shall recover all through Acts after Pentecost.
- **2.** Mark 16:20 "...the Lord working with them and confirming the word with signs following."
- 3. *Philippians 2:5-11* How do we get to this place where these things began to happen today in our lives:
 - "Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus although he was equal with God (had the same outward form as God), he came with the mind of a servant (made himself of no reputation and took on the form of a man) and humbled himself and became obedient unto the will of the Father."
 - Jesus came with the mindset that : <u>I Live and Breathe to Do the Will of God</u>. Throughout all his ministry, he constantly said "not his will, but thine be done".
 - But now God has highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name:
 - If we get to hear God say 'Well done, thy good and faithful servant', we are going to have to get to that same place that Jesus was... I Live and Breathe to do thy will.
- 4. Then as we recognize the power that is within us by the Holy Ghost and become a body of believers that pray without ceasing, with a mindset that I live and breathe to do your will...
 - Then God working with us will confirm the gospel we preach with signs and wonders will follow
 - But we will have paid the price of sanctifying ourselves unto Him and sanctifying Him in our hearts (*I Peter 3:15*).
