No Strength to Deliver

Isaiah 37:1-7 – King Hezekiah's Problem:

- The king of Assyria, Sennacherib, was on a rampage <u>conquering and defeating</u> surrounding cities
- In this story he is <u>threatening to conquer Juda</u>
- He intended to frighten Hezekiah away from God, but accomplished just the opposite
- The King recognized the day of trouble was upon them
- <u>The time of birth was upon them and there was no strength to deliver</u> **so let prayer go forth** (When a child can't proceed to be born – death of both the child and mother is imminent)
- <u>Prayer is the midwife of mercy</u> that helps to bring forth

In Chapter 36 – the enemy of God's people worked to frighten them from their confidence in <u>God</u>.

- He asked them what confidence were they relying upon, that they thought they could rebel against him?
- He told them that <u>the alliance they had with Egypt</u>, it <u>was relying upon a crushed</u> <u>reed</u>
- And if they say they trust in the Lord our God, he will remind them that it was <u>Hezekiah who torn down their alters to idols</u> appealing to the idolatrous party in Juda.
- Next he tries to persuade the people to desert Hezekiah and join him and his master
- He even tells them the Lord has sent him to go up against Juda
- He shouts so all the people on the wall of Juda can hear him questioning "Has any of the gods of all the other nations delivered his land from the hands of the King of Assyria? Where are those gods now, so what makes Israel think their God can deliver them out of his hands?
- But <u>the people were silent</u> they were told not to answer him.

At the End of Chapter 37:33-38 - GOD hears the prayers of his prophet Isaiah:

- The King will not even come into the city, nor even shoot an arrow into the city
- **The Angel of the LORD** went into the camp of the Assyrians and killed 185,000 men and "in the morning they were all dead corpses".
- King Sennacherib with no army to fight, decides to depart and return to Nineveh.
- Later he was killed by two of his own sons as he was worshipping his idol god.
- GOD heard his boasting and threats but GOD said he would fight for Israel.
- When time to give birth GOD will provide the strength and the power to deliver Just call and trust in Him!
